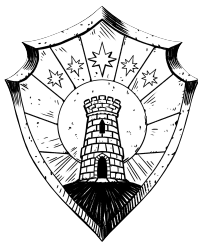


CARTOGRAPHY OF ASHLAR 2024 EDITION

The Duchy of Ashlar is a mini-campaign setting designed for low- to mid-level characters intent on wilderness exploration and dungeon-delving.
